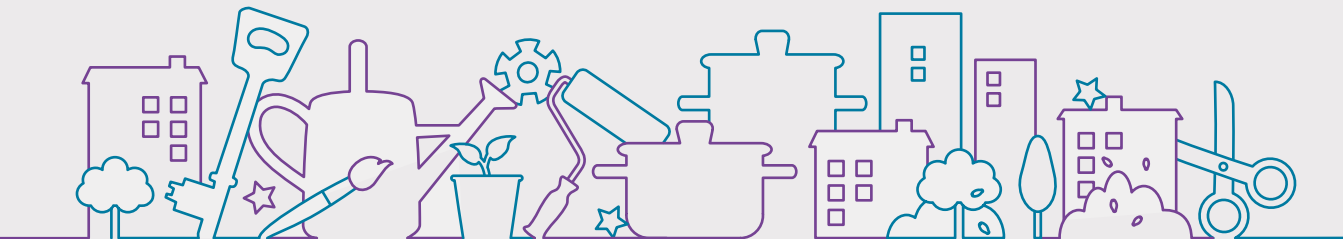




Peter Bedford's Adult Learning and Enterprises Charter
